

## **Borough of Rosslyn Farms**

**June 28, 2010**

**Special Meeting**

A Special meeting of Council held was called to order by President Kathleen Green on Monday June 28, 2010 at 7:30 PM in the Rosslyn Farms Community Center with the following members of Council in attendance: D. Robb, R. Bowen, S. Prevoznak, G. Bell, S. George, and P. McNamara. Also present was Secretary/Treasurer Maccarone.

Pres. Green opened the meeting and explained to Council that the purpose of the meeting was for the hiring of part-time employees for the street department. Charlie Smith would like part-time help now and possibly full-time for the future.

He is requesting the hiring of two local students to assist with some of the day today responsibilities. Both students, William McNamara, and Ben Prevoznak are currently working as swimming pool guards. Charlie also received the name of an experienced individual who was referred to the borough by Contractor Tito Police.

Councilperson David Robb claimed that there is additional workload for the two young men. With Charlie's additional projects for the storm and sanitation sewer system, there is not sufficient time to complete all of the normal week to week activities.

Councilperson Prevoznak pointed out that 19 years ago. The borough had a two-man maintenance crew that did not include responsibilities for a swimming pool, community center, storm drain or sanitation sewer issues .

Councilperson, George responded that the need for additional personnel is now.

A motion was made and seconded to employ Ben Prevoznak and William McNamara as assistants to the street department, on an as needed basis, for the summer of 2010 at a rate of \$10 per hour. Bowen/George, four, yea, and two abstentions, Prevoznak and McNamara.

Pres. Green cautioned Council for the hiring of children of Council members. Although this is a short-term solution, it is being done without consideration to other available applicants. Pres. Green advised Council to manage decisions by advanced planning and awareness to avoid this situation from reoccurring. She pointed out our borough recognizes these issues and are sensitive to them.


The personnel committee will review the other potential candidate with Charlie to see if he might might be a possible candidate for a part time position for the fall.

Councilperson George reported that he had submitted a package of completed documents to FEMA/PEMA requesting a reimbursement grant for February storm damages.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn. Bowen/McNamara, unanimous.
