Special Meeting

A Special meeting of Council held was called to order by President Kathleen Green on Monday August 16, 2010 7:30 PM in the Rosslyn Farms Community Center with the following members of Council in attendance: D. Robb, R. Bowen, S. Prevoznak, and S. George. Also present was Secretary/Treasurer Maccarone.

Pres. Green opened the meeting and explained to Council that the purpose of the meeting was for the hiring of additional swimming pool guard.

A motion was made and seconded to employ Mary Nemeth as a swimming pool lifeguard to finish the year. Bowen/George, unanimous.

A motion was made and seconded to advertise in the Pittsburgh Tribune Review community newspapers for a part time, temporary street department employee at the rate of \$12.50 per hour. George/Prevoznak, unanimous.

Secretary-Treasurer Maccarone gave Council an update about the requested tree trimming, near the Billboard as requested by Booze Advertising. Don Booze called to say Ken's Tree Trimming Service will be marking trees that will be trimmed for councils inspection.


President Green reported that the last bus stop in Rosslyn Farms at Winthrop Road and Kings Highway will be discontinued in a few weeks. In early September bus 26 E and 28 E will be discontinued.

Councilperson Robb gave an update on the tennis courts reconstruction project. Premier Courts should be here on Wednesday, August 18 to complete the placement of the tennis court surface. He has not received a report from Gateway Engineers since their review of the sidewalks indicated faulty construction.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn. Bowen/Prevoznak, unanimous.
