Regular Meeting

The second monthly regular meeting of Council was called to order by President Kathleen Green on Monday, October 24, 2011 at the Rosslyn Farms Community Center. Business before Council:

President Kathleen Green announced that we have received the Fernandez deed of easement, signed by both parties. Solicitor Molinaro will proceed to have the deed recorded.

A motion was made and seconded to accept the letter of retirement for Chief Larry Fishcio with his last official day of work to be August 31, 2012.

A motion was made and seconded to approve a resolution accepting the O'Toole force main - Sewage Facilities Planning Module Component 3 signed by the parties as required. Robb/Prevoznak, unanimous.

Councilperson Prevoznak reported that the new truck has been delivered to A & H Ford in Bridgeville who is completing the installation of after-market equipment within the next 4 to 6 weeks. Financing can be discussed at the November meeting.


A motion was made and seconded to approve a mailing of an Act 32 letter to all residents of Rosslyn Farms informing them of their responsibilities as a result of the passage of PA Act 32 to be effective commencing January 1, 2012. Bowen/Bell, unanimous.


Budget Review:

Councilperson Pat McNamara presented a review of the draft 2012 Budget. After the review, he will make appropriate changes and present a budget for review at the November meeting of Council. The final budget will then be advertised for approval at a meeting in December.
